

2 Corinthians 13: 14


Finally, brothers and sisters, rejoice! Strive for full restoration, encourage one another, be of one mind, live in peace. And the God of love and peace will be with you.

Greet one another with a holy kiss.







“...in spite of everything, God would love his children with a Never-Stopping, Never Giving Up, Unbreaking, Always and Forever Love.


And though they would forget him, and run from Him, deep in their hearts God’s children would miss Him always, and long for Him — lost children yearning for their home.”

...writes out of deep love for them (2 Cor 2: 4)


...his willingness to suffer in weakness because of a sincere love for his church and God. (6:6)

...with the sincerity of their love by how earnest and generous they are toward others. (8:8)


